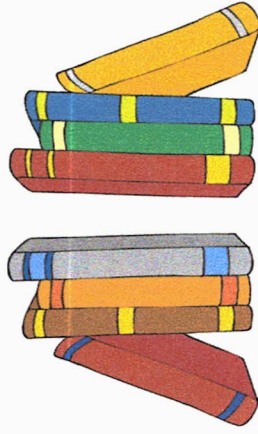

# Who are the Friends of the Library?



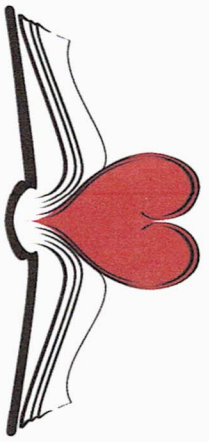
The Friends of the Granby Free Public Library is a group of men and women, young and old, who work together to support the library for all of the citizens of Granby.

The Friends meet on a monthly basis to plan fundraising activities for the daily operations of the Library. The Town includes the Library in the annual Town budget, but there often is not enough to fully support all of the needs and wishes of the Library and its users. Annual Book Sales, Plant Sales, Knitting Sales, Holiday Basket Sales and numerous other events not only bring the community together, but also supplement the Library's budget.

## Did you know...

- The Friends fund both the Youth and Adult Summer Reading Programs.
- The Friends hold a Book Sale in both the Fall and Spring which offers thousands of books for sale as low as 50 cents each!!!
- The Friends hold an Annual Plant Sale in May to help budding gardeners get excited for the new growing season!!!
- The Friends sponsor a Seed Library where gardeners can get free seeds for their gardens in return for sharing some seeds from their own harvests at season's end.
- The Friends fund Art, Photography, & Quilt Receptions and Showings, Rock and Dinosaur Programs and Genealogy Workshops, as well as many other community activities.
